- I. The need for Jesus to **enter** your life as King. John 12
 - A. Recognizing that Jesus is King of Kings is foundational to **abiding!** vv12-26
 - B. Realization of His **mission** is essential. vv27-50
- II. The need for Jesus to **sacrifice** His life for you. John 13
 - A. A demonstration of servanthood clarifies His **ministry** and ours. vv1-20
 - B. Jesus will always clarify His **mission** for Himself and for us. vv21-38
- III. The need for Jesus to **prepare** an eternal home for you. John 14
 - A. There is only one way to experience a **future** face to face eternal presence with Jesus. vv1-6
 - B. Presently believers experience the **presence** of Jesus through an abiding relationship. vv7-15
 - C. The abiding relationship is a growing **dynamic** experience through prayer and the Word. vv16-31
- IV. The need for us to **abide** in Jesus until we arrive at our eternal home. John 15
 - A. A living relationship with Jesus gives believers the ability to be abundantly **fruitful**. vv1-6
 - B. The abiding relationship with Jesus is **reality** through God's Word and prayer. vv7-8
 - C. Through a living and abiding relationship amazing love will be realized and abundant **joy** will be produced. vv9-11
