| 5. Sense timing for each one to go from established to equipped. (Col. 2:6-7) | ↔ | 5. Beware of just desiring head knowledge. (Phil. 3:17; Jn. 3:21) |
| 6. Equipping includes involvement in ministry. (Lk. 9:1-6) | ↔ | 6. Application = desire to minister. (Jn. 4:34-38) |
