III) Open \_\_\_\_\_ obedient to God's \_\_\_\_\_ (v4; Phil 2:8).

IV) Open \_\_\_\_\_ proclaiming God's word and overcoming \_\_\_\_\_ (v5-12, 13-15; Phil. 2:9-11).

## Applying God's Word to Life
