Acts 16:16-40

- I) **Proclaim** the good news as faithful witnesses for Christ (v. 16-18, 30-32; 1:8).
- II) **Persecution**, **pain**, and **prison** may raise faith **questions** as you engage in His mission (v. 19-24).
- III) **Praise** and **prayer** invite God's **perspective** and **power** (v. 25-28; Phil. 1:19-26).
- IV) **Preaching**, **perseverance** and **raise** cause others to ask life changing **questions** (v. 16-18, 29-34).
- V) **Patient** endurance provides future opportunities (v.35-40).
