Teen Challenge Choir Notes:

“Body of Christ Sunday” on March 2nd at both services.

This is a special Sunday to hear from “the people” instead of the pastor. From 1 Corinthians 12 and Ephesians 4 we understand that God has designed His body in such a way that each part needs the others; therefore, each of the “parts” need to communicate with one another to be effective for Him.
