From "Our Roots" We Learn — 2 Chronicles 36; Jeremiah 25, 29; Haggai 1

From "our roots" we learn:

- 1) **God is _____—He stands against evil** (2 Chronicles 36:5-14).

- 2) **God is _____—He pursues His people** (2 Chronicles 36:12-16; Jeremiah 25:1-7, 29:1-14; Haggai 1:1-8).

- 3) **God is _____—He is in control, even when life seems out of control** (2 Chronicles 36:17-22; Jeremiah 25:8-14).

- 4) **God is _____—He foretells the end from the beginning** (Isaiah 44:6-8, 44:24-28).

- 5) **God is _____—He fulfills His promises** (Jeremiah 29:4-14; 2 Chronicles 36:22-24; Ezra 1:7-11; Deuteronomy 28; Haggai 1:9-11).

- 6) **God blesses _____—He is "with" those who hear, revere, and respond to His word** (Haggai 1:12-15; Galatians 6:1-10).
